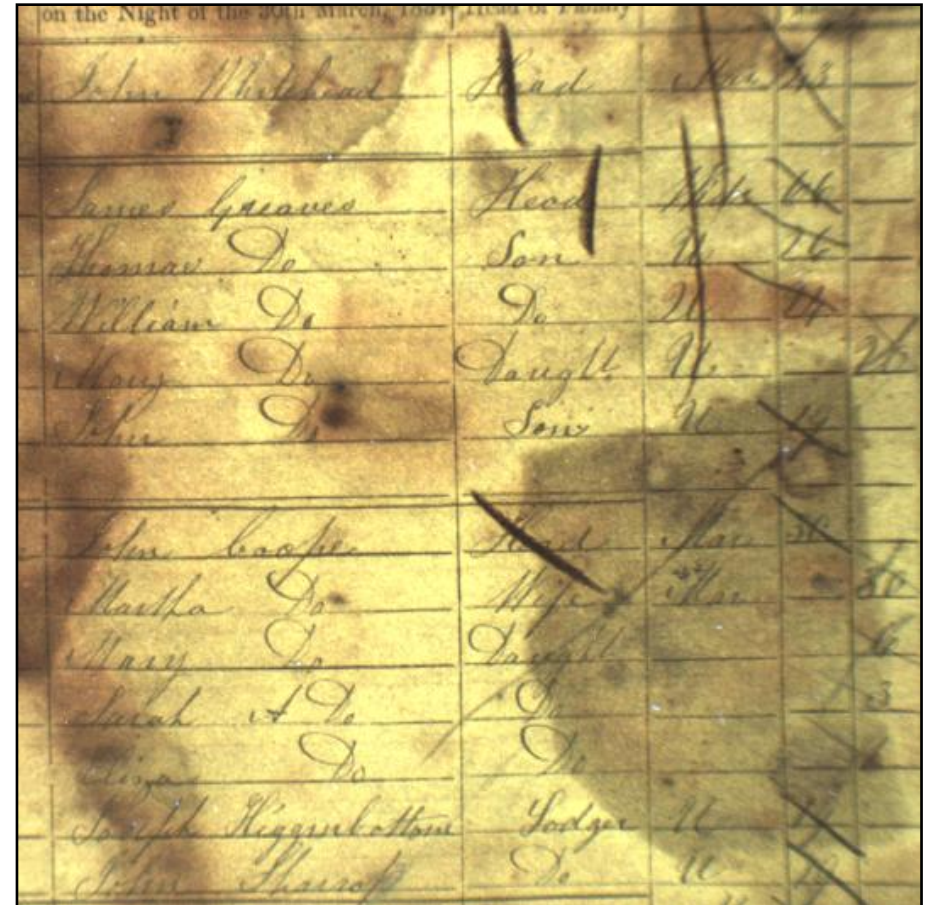

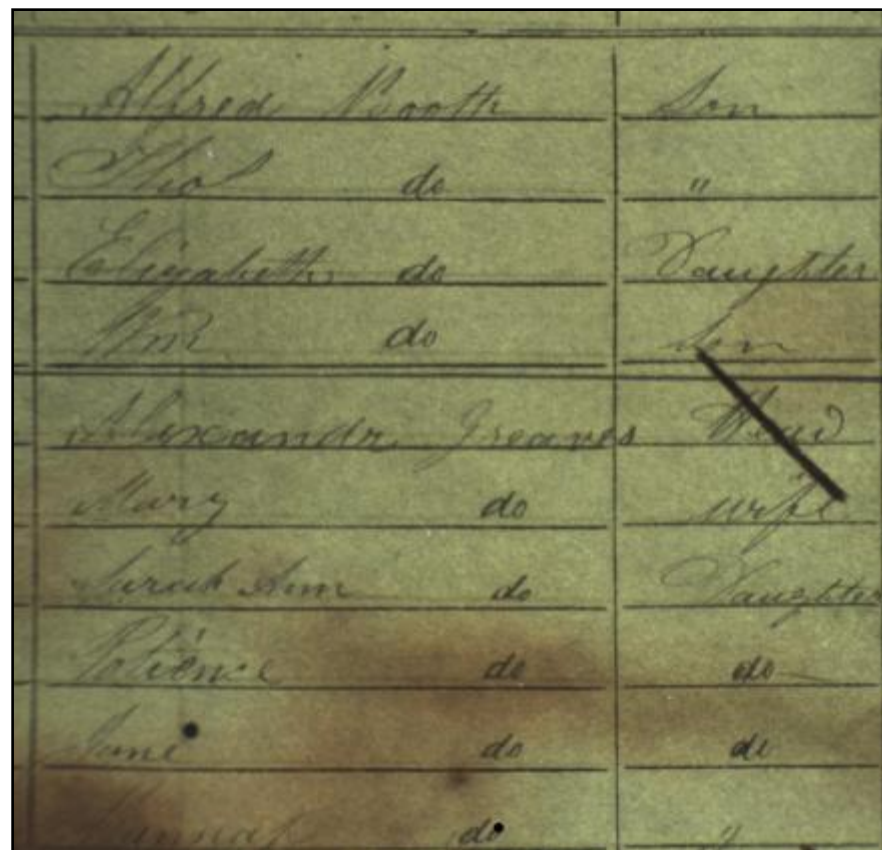
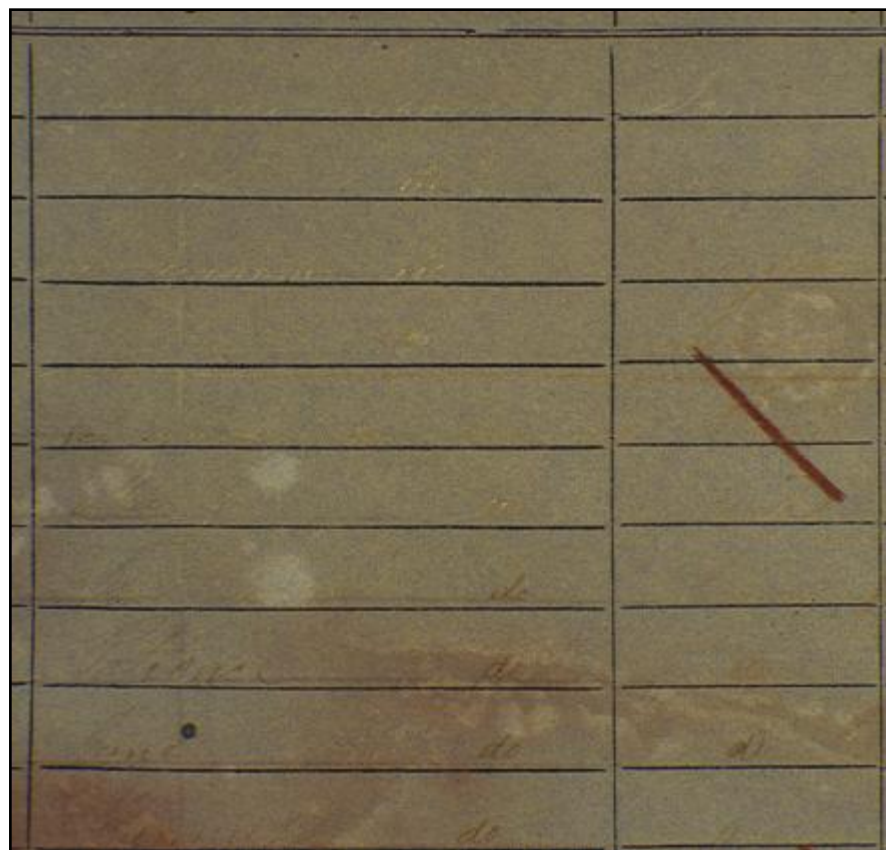
Fluorescence in Visible Spectrum under UVC Light



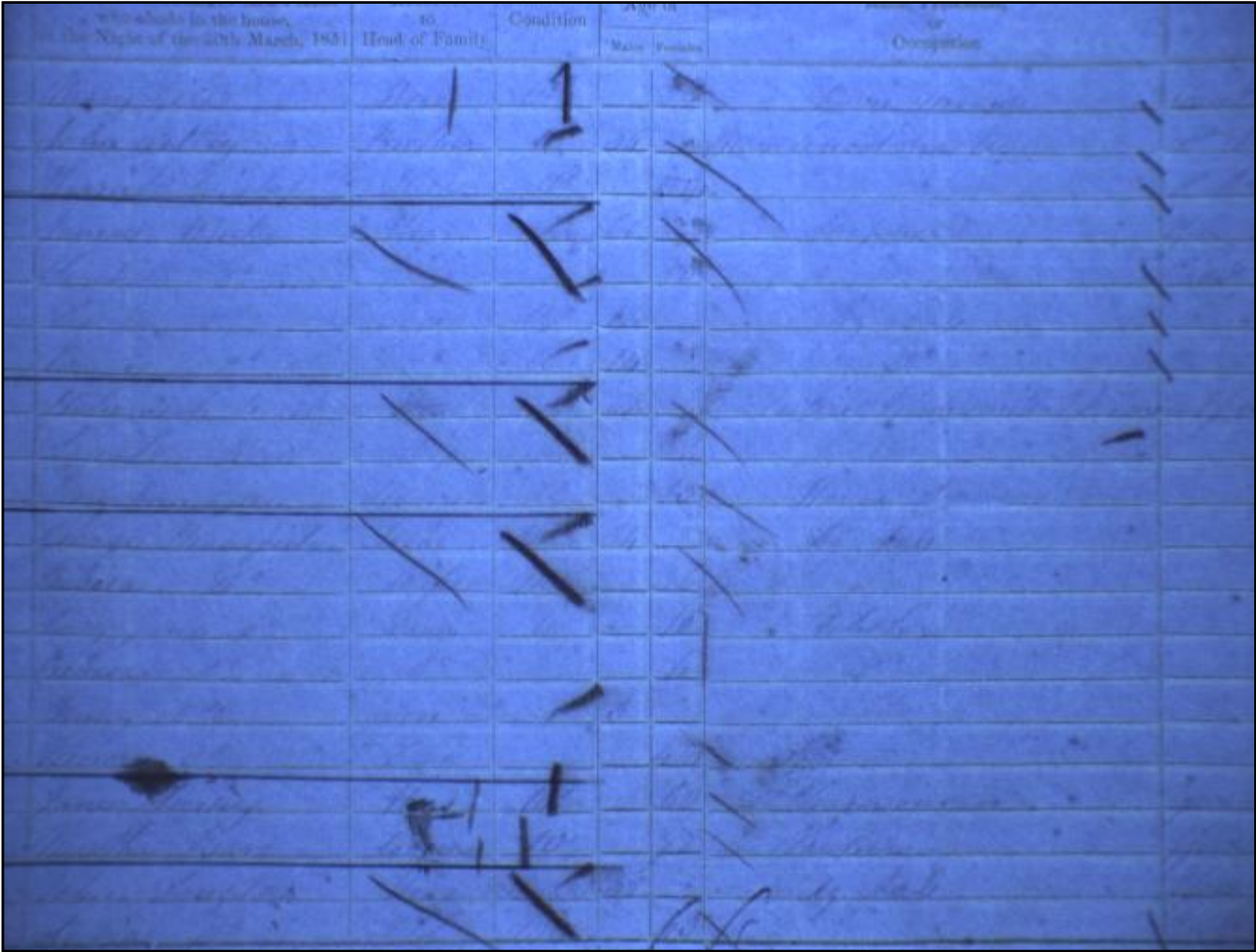
