- 9.** When did you realize we would win the war? Was there a turning point? How did that make you feel?
- 10.** Were you afraid? How did you feel?
- 11.** Were you with anyone who didn't make it back?
- 12.** What did you do in your off-time?
- 13.** How do you feel about your service now?
